Today their Zeno® Tec product is one of the most advanced on the market. We have installed the latest version of their laser scanning software that is both fast and extremely accurate.

This system currently offers the greatest scope for multi unit bridgework as frameworks are milled from a 98mm diameter disc rather than a rectangular block. To date, results and feedback have been very positive.
